**Companhia de Saneamento do Paraná – Sanepar** in compliance with the provisions of CVM Resolution No. 44/2021 and continuing to disclose the Material Facts of May 8, 2020, October 29, 2020, May 5, 2021, August 6, 2021 and November 8, 2021, hereby informs its shareholders, investors and the market at large that the Governor of the State of Paraná has decreed the recognition of the continuity of the water emergency in the State of Paraná, considering the priority use of water resources for human consumption and animal watering and considering the need for actions to increase the volume of water stored in reservoirs and to recharge the aquifers, still reflecting the drought that has persisted in Paraná for more than 2 years.

The Working Group created by Decree No. 4626, of May 7, 2020, shall monitor and produce a report on the situation, on a quarterly basis, evaluating the volume of water in the reservoirs that make up the Integrated Water Supply Systems and the recharge of aquifers, technically indicating the moment of revocation of this act.

The Decree also points out the attributions of the bodies and entities of the State of Paraná in relation to the water situation.

The sanitation service providers are authorized to perform, as a mitigating action, a 24 hour rotation considered from the interruption until the resumption of supply, with a period for normalization of up to another 24 hours. The above limits can be extrapolated in emergency maintenance situations or arising from unforeseeable circumstances and force majeure, and must be communicated to the population and inspection bodies.

Decree No. 9989, dated 12/22/2021, will remain in force for 180 days and may be revised at any time, depending on the evolution of the situation.
